

Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Commerce) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2026 (No. 15)

It is hereby notified that the Minister of Industry and Commerce, in terms of section 4(1) of the Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Commerce) Regulations, 1974, published in Rhodesia Government Notice 766 of 1974, hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. This notice shall be cited as the Control of Goods (Import and Export) (Commerce) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026 (No. 15).

2. The Control of Goods (Open General Import Licence) Notice, 1974, published in Rhodesia Government Notice No. 766 of 1974 (“hereinafter called the principal regulations”), is amended by the insertion of the following new sections after section 5—

“Rejection of applications

5A. The Secretary reserves the right to reject an application for an import or export licence if—

- (a) the goods do not meet national quality or safety standards;
- (b) the importation or exportation of such goods is deemed prejudicial to the economic interests of Zimbabwe; or
- (c) the applicant has previously contravened the provisions of these regulations

Fees for import and export licences

5B. (1) An import application fee of one hundred United States dollars (US\$100), or the equivalent in local currency at the prevailing interbank rate of exchange, shall be payable by an applicant prior to the issuance of an import licence.

(2) An export application fee of fifty United States dollars (US\$50), or the equivalent in local currency at the prevailing interbank rate of exchange, shall be payable by an applicant prior to the issuance of an export licence.

(3) For the avoidance of doubt, the fees prescribed in terms of this section are non-refundable application fees, and the

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Secretary shall not process or issue any licence until the applicant has produced proof of such payment.

Procedures, requirements and exemptions for licences

5C. (1) The procedures and documentary requirements for an application for an import or export licence shall be as set out in Part I of the Third Schedule.

(2) The goods and categories of persons exempted from the requirement of an import licence shall be as set out in Part II of the Third Schedule.

(3) The conditions for the collection of an approved licence shall be as set out in Part III of the Third Schedule.”.

3. The principal regulations are amended by the insertion of the following, after section 7—

“Control of importation of second-hand motor vehicle

7A. (1) Second-hand vehicles aged ten (10) years and above from the date of manufacture classified under headings specified in the Second Schedule shall not be imported.

(2) Notwithstanding any administrative delays or processes pending with any other statutory authority, no import licence shall be issued for motor vehicles referred to in subsection (1).

(3) Any vehicle imported in contravention of subsection (1) shall be re-exported by the owner, at their own expense.

(4) If any second-hand motor vehicle is not re-exported within sixty (60) days, such vehicle shall be deemed forfeited to the State subject to the provisions of the Customs and Excise Act [*Chapter 23:02*].

(5) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the following second-hand motor vehicles aged ten years and above shall be allowed entry into Zimbabwe—

- (a) vehicles belonging to deceased estates (inherited motor vehicles); or
- (b) vehicles belonging to an immigrant as defined in terms of section 9 NO (1) of the Customs and Excise

Suspension Regulations, 2003, published in Statutory Instrument 257 of 2003; or

- (c) vehicles belonging to an immigrant as defined in terms of section 105(1) of the Customs and Excise (General) Regulations, 2001, published in Statutory Instrument 154 of 2001; or
- (d) vehicles belonging to diplomats returning to Zimbabwe from their postings; or
- (e) vintage vehicles as defined in the Vehicle Registration and Licensing Act [*Chapter 13:14*].

Control of importation of second-hand clothing and undergarment

7B.(1) The importation of second-hand clothing is prohibited, except where the importer has obtained a valid permit authorising the importation for charitable purposes only, subject to such conditions as the Secretary may prescribe in writing to ensure the goods are for charitable distribution.

(2) The importation of second-hand undergarments is strictly prohibited under all circumstances.”.

4. The principal regulations are amended in section 13A by the insertion of the following subsection after subsection (2)—

“(3) Any person who—

- (a) imports or exports goods in contravention of these regulations;
- (b) makes a false statement in an application for a licence; or
- (c) sells a licence or permit issued in terms of these regulations;

shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding level twelve or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding one year, or to both such fine and such imprisonment.”.

5. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is repealed and the following is substituted—

THIRD SCHEDULE (*Section 5C*)

PART I

APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

General requirements

1. (1) Every application for an import licence shall be made by way of an application letter addressed to the Permanent Secretary for Industry and Commerce at the Harare or Bulawayo provincial offices.

(2) A separate application shall be submitted for each different product category.

Company applications

2. Applications by a company or juristic person shall include a brief company profile indicating the line of business and the following details regarding the consignment—

- (a) product description and relevant tariff code;
- (b) quantity, expressed in the appropriate unit of measure;
- (c) purchase price or selling price per unit;
- (d) total value of the consignment and the country of origin or destination; and
- (e) the goods cannot be sourced locally.

Supporting documents for companies

3. Every company application shall be accompanied by—

- (a) a Certificate of Incorporation and a Form CR14;
- (b) a valid Tax Clearance Certificate;
- (c) a copy of the Standards Development Fund (SDF) levy receipt; and
- (d) a proforma invoice for the intended imports.

Individual applicants

4. Applications by individuals shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the applicant's National Identity Document or valid Passport and a written justification for the import.

PART II

EXEMPTIONS FROM IMPORT LICENSING

1. An individual may, once per calendar month, import the following goods for personal use without an import licence, provided the quantities do not exceed—

- (a) cooking oil (4 litres);
- (b) sugar (4 kg);

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- (c) cereals (2 kg);
- (d) jam (2 kg);
- (e) peanut butter (2 kg);
- (f) margarine (2 kg);
- (g) laundry bar soap (1 box of 24 bars);
- (h) washing powder (4 kg);
- (i) one (1) blanket;
- (j) four (4) pieces of cotton woven fabric; and
- (k) body creams or petroleum jellies (1 case of 6).

2. An import licence shall not be required for the importation of personal goods belonging to—

- (a) deceased estates (inheritance goods);
- (b) diplomats based abroad;
- (c) returning residents with immigrant status; and
- (d) returning residents who have resided continuously outside Zimbabwe for a period of not less than six months.

PART III

COLLECTION OF LICENCES

1. (1) An approved licence shall only be collected by the applicant or a representative of the applicant.

(2) Upon collection, an individual applicant shall produce a National Identity Document or valid Passport.

(3) A representative of a company or juristic person shall produce—

- (a) their own identification particulars; and
- (b) a formal letter of authorisation on the applicant's letterhead.
